ARCSA Seeking Architectural Services

The Asian Resource Center of San Antonio (ARCSA) is seeking a qualified architectural firm to provide design services for an Asian Resource Center (Center) that will serve as a cultural, educational, and community hub. The center will celebrate and promote Asian heritage, arts, and traditions while offering space for events, exhibitions, educational programs, and community engagement.

The proposed Center will be located at Stone Oak Parkway (Lot 5, Block 3), San Antonio, Texas 78258. The project is planned to have two phases. Phase I will include a multifunctional facility of 9,500 square feet that consists of event space to hold 400 to 450 people, a food preparation area, a multi-purpose reception area, and office space for community meetings, workshops, and training sessions. The garden and the plaza are currently scheduled to be in Phase II, but depending on the capital funds raised, they could be part of Phase I development.

The selected architectural firm will be responsible for:

- Developing conceptual, schematic, and final design plans
- Preparing construction documents and cost estimates
- Ensuring compliance with local building codes and sustainability guidelines
- Collaborating with stakeholders to ensure cultural and functional requirements are met
- Providing project management support during construction
